405.000 ha (42%) - 91 local areas – Q. py; P. sy; P. n; Pop. sp.


- 27 members:

#### Relaunch project and activities (slide 1/2)

#### 1.- Palencia Model Forest Project financed by Spanish Government ():

- 1.1. Certification of International Model Forest Network (in the short term)
- 1.2. MONBIOFOR App: Data analysis of forest resources and local bioeconomy
- 1.3. Fire prevention plans at local level
- 1.4. Mobilization of quality wood implementing Close to Nature Silviculture in demonstrative stands

  New forest management plants under PEFC certification

  Higher economic value to the local forest
- 1.5. Creation of new regulated areas for sustainable mushroom harvesting
- 1.6. (4) Bioeconomy laboratories with a gender perspective:

  Creation of the roadmap of 8 natural resources and support for the 2 best initiatives
- 1.7. (2) Training courses in CNS
- 1.8. Potential visibility of the activities in the territory through social networks and PMF website to involve local people.















### Relaunch project and activities (slide 2/2)





- 1.1. ADaFoRM Local tool for
  - Self-diagnosis of the local forest management and its adaptation strategy against climate change
  - Fire prevention plans at local level
- 1.2. Desing and execution of a self-interpreting route based on a local example of adaptative forest management
- 1.3 Potential visibility of the activities in the territory through PILA project and PMF social networks.
- 2.- SINGLE TREE Project: Optimizing multifunctional forest-based value chains with single tree information and application of digital technologies.
  - 1.1. 3 living labs, Sweden (North), Switzerland (Central) and Spain (South). The Spanish LLVC will be in the area of Palencia Model Forest, in a Pinus sylvestris forest.
  - 1. 2. Create a Living Lab Value Chain area that function as innovative ecosystem in real life environments, using iterative feedback process throughout the value chain a lifecycle approach to create sustainable impact of fully connected single tree based multifunctional value chain.
  - 1.3 Potential visibility of the activities in the territory through SINGLE TREE project and PMF social networks.




























### Challenges and way forward
