






Eligible Activities and Scale & Scope of the IMFN

- Strengthening partnerships with international and domestic stakeholders like the International Model Forest Network (IMFN).
- Sharing Canadian expertise in forest practices, products, standards, and technologies through bilateral and multilater engagements.
- Promoting sustainable forest products by addressing trade barriers and advocating through multilateral fora.
- Raising domestic awareness of international forest policy trends and testing new forest management approaches with partners.
- Advancing innovative forest products as sustainable alternatives to non-renewable materials in global markets.
- Responding to international requests for wildland fire and forest stewardship assistance.
- Developing tools and training for monitoring climate and environmental metrics, such as greenhouse gas levels.



CG is investing \$18.7 million to scale up Nature-Based Leadership Platforms.

Through partnerships with the IMFN in ODA-eligible countries, this investment will boost forest and landscape restoration, support inclusive governance, and prepare future forest leaders to tackle climate change and biodiversity loss.

- we had to have a good understanding of the criteria, eligible actions and interventions, programme objectives and priorities
- We had to find, with our canadian colleagues, ways to solve a lot of burocratic issues...TR and FMMF
- Need (urgency!) to articulate a three-year project that could provide benefits as widespread as possible to all MMFN members but within the priorities determined by the programme both in terms of priority countries (ODA) and objectives....a complicated balance
- ...so short time!!!
- And mainly for the first year....we have the deadline to finish and report next march 31 2024



1. Analysis tool and Validation (2024 / 2025 / 2026)



Technical support and coordination for landscape restoration activities in ODA (Official Development Assistance) countries.

Development of a web-based tool for identifying potential areas suitable for forest restoration projects, promotion, and monitoring of land-use changes (Agadir commitment 2017).

Field validation and prioritization of identified areas (on the web platform) for landscape restoration activities in the Model Forests and Model Forest Initiative of Ifrane (Morocco), Midelt (Morocco), Tlemcen (Algeria), Shouf (Lebanon), and Model Forests in the northern Mediterranean basin.

Monitoring and updating to contribute data for the Agadir commitment.

Forest pedagogy and environmental education for Forest Landscape Restoration this project will work on accessibility, inclusion and digital education by providing the MFs with cutting edge tools for their education and dissemination activities.

To present the tools and their potential a dedicated workshop will be organized in Italy in March 2024, inviting representatives from all the MFs of the Mediterranean Network and some experts from the IMFN and other networks





Set of videos on results, stories and best practices from the FLR projects developed within the MMFN,

These short documentaries will show the MFs territories and the way the local communities are involved in projects related to FLR.

Subtitles and voice translation will be provided to give the opportunities to all the MFs to use them as tools for dissemination and engagement with local communities. This kind of product will be also very useful to engage new countries, subjects and/or territories interested in joining the Network.















3. Landscape and Forest Restoration (2024)

Forest reforestation activities in Morocco (10 ha in Ifrane MF and 10 ha Midelt initiative MF) through actions including planting of forestry planting stock, involvement of local comunities addressed a sustainable manegment of terriotries and the reintroduction of traditional manegmaent of pasture ("Agdal") with the aim of accelerating the recovery of an ecosystem from a degraded condition. Reforestation and landscape restoration interventions converge on the goal of achieving a forested area capable of sustaining the socioeconomic life of the area. Integrate the ongoing restoration project (LOA with FAO fundend by IKI, for a total amount of 35 ha in Ifrane MF and 30 ha in Midelt initiative MF).

4. Environmental education 2024-EDUCASE project

Improving Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Accessibility (IDEA) trough forest pedagogy and environmental education for Forest and Landscape Restoration.

- Joëlette (a special wheelchair to ensure accessibility to mountain trails for those with motor disabilities),
- Photo traps
- PlantsPlay (sensors that translate electrical changes in plants into sounds),
- Kit for wolf howling or deer roaring
- Orienteering kit
- Time Lapse camera
- Digital microscope and climate station

To present the tools and their potential we organized a dedicated workshop in Italy in March 2024, inviting representatives from MF of Ifrane (Marocco), Western Macedonia (Greece), Media Valle dell'Aterno (Italy), Provence (France), Istria (Croatia), Tlemcen (Algeria), and Voskopoja Model Forest Initiative (Albania) and as guest Juan Pablo Rodriguez Garavito from Colombia, delegate of the Latin-American Model Forest Network. It has been the perfect occasion for sharing knowledge among the MFs of the Mediterranean on the potential of education and dissemination to include the communities in the FLR projects.

5. Video Guidelines for Landscape Restoration 2025/2026

- **Design** of the narrative structure of the videos, identification of the good practices to be told and the subjects to be interviewed in the various model forests involved.
- A set of 6 videos of 10-12 minutes each
- Missions of 3-5 days each for filming with 2 people CdF in 5 areas (Morocco, Algeria, Lebanon, + 2 in no ODA countries)
- Translation of content into 4 languages (English, French, Spanish + Italian for interviews)
- Speaker involvement for voice-over (4 voices for 4 languages English, French,

Spanish, italian)

6. Pilot sites 2026

Providing technical support and coordination, also through hiring of a arabic and/or french speaking consultant for restoration activities in Morocco (Ifrane MF and Arebica initiative MF), Algeria (Tlemcen MF) and Lebanon (Shouf MFs Initiative) through different actions including planting trees, assessment of the current conditions of the forest, implementation of fire management practices with the aim of accelerating the recovery of an ecosystem from a degraded condition, by the involvement of local comunities. Reforestation and landscape restoration interventions converge on the goal of achieving a forested area capable of sustaining the socioeconomic life of the area.

In the 2026, in order to have a firts application of the work done and the prioritization, pilot sites will be establish in each MFs of ODA Countries in areas of at least 5000 sq.m


7. Scholarship 2025/2026
